ELIGIBILITY

Current MoFA membership is required to participate. All members are encouraged to participate.

ARTWORK

- * Up to 3 fiber pieces may be entered.
- * Work should follow the exhibit's theme of inspiration from Latin America and completed in the last 2 years.
- * Work should be priced and marked for sale or not for sale (NFS).
- * 2-D work should be ready to install; no size restrictions.
- * No size restrictions on wearable fiber pieces or 3-D freestanding work.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Digital images only. Due July 1, 2009

One detail photo and one overall photo of each piece should be on your CD. Please save image as a jpeg format using 72 dpi resolution and sized at 4"x6". Clearly write the titles of your pieces as they appear in order on your CD with your name.

Fee: \$15.00 for one to three entries; make check payable to Missouri Fiber Artists.

ACCEPTED WORK

Notification for accepted work will be mailed August 1, 2009.

- * **All work must be ready to exhibit.** Artist name, title and installation requests must accompany artwork. Please be specific as to how your work should be hung, ex. vertical, horizontal, etc. You will receive mailing instructions and/or drop-off dates for your work with your acceptance notification.
- * **It is at the discretion of the exhibit committee to reject any work that has been misrepresented from the original jurying process, or if a different piece has been sent from the originally accepted piece.**
- * **There will be a 60/40 standard commission fee on work sold.**
- * **It is the responsibility of individual artists to insure their work. The Missouri Fiber Artists organization and The Old Orchard Gallery will not be liable for participants' work. All reasonable precautions and safety will be afforded to the work during the exhibition.**
